

COVID-19

Essential Health Questionnaire

For Easington Parish Council

Meeting Attendees

This might include (but is not limited to) the following questions:

- 1. Have you tested positive or had treatment for COVID-19 ?**
- 2. Have you, or has anyone you are in close contact with, had any of the following signs or symptoms associated with coronavirus: -**
 - High temperature - this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back.
 - New, continuous cough – this means coughing for a lot more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual).
 - Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste - this means you have noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.
- 3. Have you been following the social distancing measures outlined by the Government during COVID-19 ?**
- 4. Have you been in contact with someone currently suffering COVID-19 or who is self-isolating ?**
- 5. Are you or anyone you live with in the high risk (clinically extremely vulnerable) group ?**

If the answer to any of the above questions is positive then please do not attend the meeting.

Any Councillors, Ward Councillors, Clerk or members of the public are requested not to attend if they or anyone within their household or anyone they have been in direct contact with within the last 2 weeks are displaying symptoms outlined above.

Members of the public attending the meeting which is unfortunately restricted to 6 in number to ensure social distancing, will be asked for contact details which will be held by the Clerk for 21 days after the meeting. This will enable 'Track and Trace' should anyone fall ill after the meeting with COVID-19.

All Councillors details are already held by the Clerk.
