Proposal: Erection of a new Visitor Centre, construction of new car park, habitat creation within Clubley's Field and associated landscaping work (Revised scheme of 15/03947/PLF)

Location: Land South East Of the Dovecote Spurn Road Kilnsea East Riding Of Yorkshire HU12 0UH

Applicant: Yorkshire Wildlife Trust

Application type: Strategic – Full Planning Permission

Decision: To object to the planning application
