- Minutes of the meeting on Monday 5th December 2016 for approval:
- Public Forum
 - Robina Herrington requested permission to replace the bench in the cemetery - agreed
 - A MOP raised that the issue of anti-social behaviour in the village which had been reported had now been dealt with and urged others to reports such issues to the anti-social behaviour team based in Hull.
 - Andrea Clubley raised the ongoing issue of the lack of salting on Seaside Road and that a truck with caravan had got stuck – the clerk to order two salt bins and one to be placed on the land at Blackwell Pond and one at the corner to Easington Road.
 - Jan Crowther: how much did the community get from the Eon community fund and did the PC feel this was enough, it was agreed that it wasn't and for the clerk to write to Eon accordingly.
 - RH: The bus shelter at Hull Road crossroads should be replaced –
 - MD: The Clough at Easington needs attention – the clerk to report that the boards to the side need to be extended.

3. Cllr Tucker – Ward Councillor update

The ambulance services will be offering CPR training for villages which will lead to an increase in the CFR scheme.

Brilliant service had been given by the police during the recent expected tidal surge, very visible, offering support before, during and after. Cllr Tucker had written to thank them.

Library and Leisure Centre services will not be closed.

MIU consultation was now complete, looking like Drifffield, Withernsea and Hornsea services will stay but with restricted hours of opening.

YWT Visitor Centre planning application: The flood risk plan will be standalone from the Parish risk plan – a copy will be sent to the clerk.

The path way to the VC from Cliff Farm to the Warren will not be closed, roving ranger will have 4.5 hrs committed when car park is up and running.

There is to be a Spurn Recreational Group and the Spurn Advisory Group will be pivotal to advise this, SBOT & RNLI will be present on the group as will the Chair and Vice Chair of the Parish Council, together with invited representatives from the community.

There will be no provision for class rooms within the centre, but there will be supervised visits.

6. Community Information

The new defibrillator for Kilnsea will be installed shortly and the training session is booked for Saturday 25th February 10am for new people and 2pm for refresher training, we only have a few people for the morning session so please register ASAP with the clerk or Andrea Clubley. This kit saves lives. Only one person has said they would like to be trained, so far.

Amenities in the Village.

Discussion regarding the current facilities available and the way forward – Cllr Nicholson – the Granby has now reduced the number of shop hours it is open and the former shop in the village was up for sale and asked if there was potential for a community shop. Cllr Dr Livas-Dawes advised that she was investigating the possibility of Post Office provision in the village for one day per week. She also discussed the possibility of a market in the village.

Spurn Advisory Group meeting 11.01.2017 – Cllr(s) Clubley & Smith attended the meeting, the group had been set up to improve relations with the community and representatives from the RNLI, SBOT and invited representatives from the community attended. The purpose of the group was outlined and three issues would be discussed at the next meeting.

7. Grass cutting agreement

Two Quotes have been received. Discussion and agreement of the scope of work outlined by Cllr Walters – This was agreed, the clerk to send this out to companies wishing to quote.

8. Coastal Opportunities Group

Cllr Nicholson updated, Yorkshire water had been asked for a site visit to advise about water supply and foul water disposal. Next COG meeting will be at the end of March.

9. Website update

Cllr Nicholson - The website is now complete and awaiting technical assistance from ERYC – Cllr Clubleby said this could be linked to SHAPE.

10. Human Resources matters

Discussion re Job descriptions, rates of pay and risk assessments are now complete for all PC employees – these would be circulated and agreed at the next meeting.

11. Emergency plan

Emergency plan review update and discussion – Cllr Walters, a basic review had been done and the plan needs updating and testing as it was out of date. A meeting of the subcommittee to be arranged to carry out a full review and recommend updates to the Parish Council.
